### What does the role involve?

Public events are an opportunity to engage and inspire people with the power of natural green spaces, while having fun and creating memories. We want you to be a part of offering these opportunities to visitors to the Earth Trust.

**Time required:** It's up to you! Flexible & varied depending on Event type, often on weekends or during school holidays

#### Tasks:

- Welcome and direct visitors throughout our site
- Manage car parking
- Check tickets or take payments
- Help with event preparation, setting and clearing up
- Facilitation or helping with craft and other event activities
- Engaging visitors and families with event themes

### What skills and experience do you need?

Most of our volunteer roles do not require in-depth previous experience as we provide a full induction, but the following skills and attributes would make you particularly suited for this role:

- Reliable and trustworthy
- Confidence in interacting with members of the public

- Flexibility and willingness to muck in as required

### **What support you will receive?**

All volunteers receive our Volunteer Handbook & Safety Guide and are invited to Insight sessions, exclusive events for our volunteers as well as learning and development events across the year.

You will have a dedicated staff member to support you and offer advice and guidance. Your induction will include information about the work of the Trust and the impact it has for our beneficiaries, and you will be provided with all materials needed.
