What does the role involve?

- Working as part of a small team undertaking a variety of practical tasks across the Earth Trust Farm, such as fencing, hedge laying, tree planting.
- Attending specialist training if required, e.g. chainsaw, First Aid, tractor driving.
- Acting as an Earth Trust representative whilst on site.
- Adhering to the Earth Trust policies and codes of practice and risk assessments.

We are the proud guardian of 500 hectares of farmland, woodland, and wetland on the bank of the River Thames and need as much help as possible to look after this amazing green space.
