



## **Volunteer Community Warden**

**When:** One hour per week

### **What does the role involve?**

- Visit the site once a week/once a month to check on a number of features on the reserve e.g. benches are intact and not vandalised, or gates are in good working order. Report anything out of the ordinary to the Community Reserves Warden.
- Make a note of any interesting wildlife that you spot on your visit.
- Provide an early warning about threats to the health and safety of the visiting public, such as: fallen or broken tree branches; large holes in/damage to footpaths; the presence of broken glass or other dangerous rubbish; etc.
- Feedback details of any inappropriate behaviour or vandalism.
- Litter pick.
- Report back to the Community Reserves Warden via the online form after your visit to let them know how it went.

- Love of walking and being outdoors!
- Enthusiasm
- Your own transport to get to the community reserve/s
