What does the role involve?

- Desk-based research into companies, trusts, foundations and public grant schemes.
- Information gathering typically within the public domain including basic contact details like address, email, website and any other relevant information where available.
- Recording results of research using Microsoft Office or Google Docs.
- Occasionally checking and updating existing organisational information. For example, updating contact details, linked personnel.
- Where agreed and with support and relevant training, upload of information into the Earth Trust database.

What attitudes, skills and experience do I need?

- A commitment to the aims and principles of Earth Trust
- Being open, approachable and enthusiastic and able to work as part of a team
- Able to support independently agreed to timescales
- Familiarity and confidence with basic software and internet searches
- An ability to communicate clearly both orally and in writing
- The ability to quickly sift through information and extract what is relevant
- An understanding of why confidentiality is important
- A positive attitude to self-development and assessment.

Why Earth Trust needs you:

Earth Trust is a charity which gives free access to wildlife-rich, natural green spaces within reach of communities in Abingdon, Didcot and Wallingford. We run learning programmes for schools and the general public including for disabled and disadvantaged groups. Looking after our green spaces and running our learning programmes requires funding, and so we have a staff fundraising team. Success in fundraising depends on good research to help minimise the time wasted making lengthy applications with a low chance of success. Thorough research is key in helping us to focus our fundraising activity and use our limited resources to best effect.
