Spring is a magical time of the year. Take time outside of the classroom to explore our farm as nature begins to awaken. Your class will start their adventures with a senses safari to the iconic Wittenham Clumps. Climbing Round Hill to take in inspiring views of the Oxfordshire countryside your pupils will use all 5 of their senses to smell, see, touch, hear and taste, bringing this wonderous season to life. In the afternoon, your class will get up close to the Earth Trust sheep with a visit to our shepherd Fred's rare sheep breeds and new born lambs. Your pupils will learn about basic sheep husbandry and why sheep are important to help us look after our land. Your pupils will leave Earth Trust feeling more connected to nature and our world.

Learning Outcomes

In addition to immersing themselves in our unique outdoor classroom, pupils will be able to:

- Observe changes in nature including spiring growth
- Introduced to animal reproduction and the stages of animal growth
- Understand the vital role animals for human use and for nature

National Curriculum links

Our Spring Senses & Lambing session covers:

- Identify which part of the body is associated with each sense
- Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults
- Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals for survival (water, food and air)
- Working scientifically to observe and compare different textures, sounds and smells
