Developed for Key Stage 1 & 2 Capacity: Up to 90 pupils per day Timings: 10am - 2pm Cost: £10 per child; minimum £250 per session.

Escape the classroom and be transported back to the Stone Age. We have designed a day that will immerse your pupils in a landscape steeped in history and bring the Stone Age to life. We will spark pupils' curiosity by giving them an opportunity to connect with prehistory in a tangible way; testing their stone age life skills, handling genuine artefacts, foraging, shelter building and cooking on an open fire. They will also create their own Stone Age cave painting using inspiration from ancient art. Your class will come away from the day inspired and eager to return to the classroom to learn more!
