

What does the role involve?

In 2023, we piloted a young volunteers scheme with the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze award and we are now looking for an enthusiastic volunteer to support the launch of our young volunteers offer, to co-ordinate the current young people on the scheme, and help us to develop and grow this in 2024 and beyond.

In this role, key ongoing co-ordinator responsibilities will be:

- Onboarding new young volunteers: running induction sessions, ordering equipment, etc
- Being a point of contact between young volunteers and Earth Trust, inc once a week check-ins
- Checking evidence of volunteering and signing off DofE assessor reports
- **Time required:** 1-2 hours per week

In addition, we are looking for someone who will be able to support the growth phase:

- Liaise with DofE to expand our offer to encompass their Silver and Gold awards
- Review opportunities to align our programme with green careers skills
- Develop the pilot young person's roles, sessions and materials
- Identify opportunities to expand our reach, to new schools, clubs, etc
- With the support of the Volunteer Officer, develop a young person's volunteering plan, in line with the Earth Trust Volunteering Plan
- **Time required:** 1-2 hours per week

What skills and experience do you need?

No previous experience is needed, however the following skills and attributes would be helpful:

Good communication skills and a friendly approach

An enthusiasm for volunteering, with a passion for young people's engagement and green skills

Knowledge of the DofE programme or other young person's volunteering

Strong organisational skills, a creative problem solver, project management experience

Computer literate with good MS ppt, excel and word competency

A DBS check is a requirement of this role, we will organise this if you do not have a current certificate.

What support will you receive?

Briefing on the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze, Silver and Gold schemes, and assessor reporting

processes

Briefing on Earth Trust young volunteer roles, induction and role training process

Assistance and guidance from the staff team through the project development phase

Lead staff member to oversee your volunteer experience with Earth Trust
