Your visit


This Easter, let your child explore a world of adventure at the Outdoor Explorer Camp at Earth Trust. Set amongst the meadows, woodland and historic hilltops of Wittenham Clumps, our day time camp is designed to give children aged 7-13 a chance to connect with nature, try new skills, make friends and enjoy an unforgettable outdoor experience.

With our expert instructors to guide them, your child will get the chance to build shelters and try their hands at some ancient crafts such as cordage or creating a wattle and daub wall. They will learn new bushcraft skills such as lighting fires, knots, wood carving and whittling. Make and enjoy fireside snacks or cook up a whole feast on our campfire or tepee fireside stoves. Explore the meadows and woods on an orienteering adventure.

Each day is different, so whether you book a single day or the three full day experiences, there will always be something new to discover.

What happens during the day?

- Arrival at Earth Trust from 8.45 - 9.15 @ Welcome Hub
- Meet our outdoor tutors - Games to get to know the group
- 2 morning sessions to enjoy outdoor activities in either our woodlands or on Wittenham Clumps
- Lunch is in our new tepee camp
- 2 afternoon sessions - to explore more of our outdoor spaces
- Return to camp for more games before pick up at 3.30 - 4.00pm

Explorer Camp - FAQs

How many children in a group?

There will be a maximum of 16 children with upto 5 DBS checked adults to supervise the activities. Staff are 1st aid trained

Is lunch provided?

No, so please bring snacks, a packed lunch and a refillable water bottle.
We will be doing some exciting campfire cooking on all 4 days. Ingredients are supplied

What should we bring?

A small day sack to carry your things. Waterproof clothes are essential and welly boots are strongly recommended

What happens if it rains?

All days are based outdoors, however, we do have use of the tepees throughout the sessions. Advertised activities are subject to weather conditions

Can I stay with my child?

This is a drop off event. Parents and carers are not allowed to stay. It is natural for some children to be nervous, but our trained staff will help them to overcome this and have fun

What time is drop-off /pick-up?

Please aim to drop your child between 8.45 and 9.15. Pick-up is between 3.30 and 4pm.

My child has specific dietary requirements

Let us know when booking of any dietary requirements - Vegan / Gluten and Dairy Free alternatives are available if requested

My child has specific medical or learning needs

Let us know when booking of any medical or learning needs.
Note: that we are unable to accommodate children who require 1:1 supervision

What if my child is ill?

If your child is not feeling well, we cannot accept them on site until they are symptom free for 24 hours. We may be able to transfer your child to another day during the week
