### What does the role involve?

Sitting within such a striking natural landscape, sometimes we forget to give our buildings some love, so we're looking for a photographer to help us showcase Earth Trust Centre in all its glory.

The site photographer will capture the beauty of our 19th century heritage barns throughout the year - across blazing summers, golden autumns, crisp winters and dewy springs - to help us show party planners and newly engaged couples that summer isn't the only season for a celebration.

Earth Trust Centre is also undergoing some exciting developments this year, so we'd love the site photographer to be our fly-on-the-wall and photograph exciting updates and milestones across the development.

**Time required:** Up to one day per month

**Tasks:** Take photographs showcasing our barns and buildings looking their best in all seasons, as well as development moments across our site.

### What skills and experience do you need?

This role would suit someone with their own camera and some experience in photography, whether that's an amateur photographer with an interest in architecture, interiors and landscaping, or an aspiring professional looking to gain some experience and build up their portfolio.

Capturing the best of our buildings across the seasons will mean working in a variety of weather conditions, so you'll need a willingness to wrap up against the weather, and an ability to adapt photography for different light levels.

In this role you will work closely with our marketing team to develop a shot list for each visit, which will be an excellent opportunity to flex your own creativity to help us achieve the best results.

### **What support you will receive?**

All volunteers receive our Volunteer Handbook & Safety Guide and are invited to Insight sessions, exclusive events for our volunteers as well as learning and development events across the year.

You will be supported by Earth Trust's marketing team and have a dedicated staff member to support you and offer role specific training.

Your induction will include an introduction to our marketing team, and a site tour to get familiarised with our celebration spaces and our planned site developments. We'll discuss how your photography will be used across our activities and develop a creative process to guide your work each time you visit us.
